Position: Maintenance Director

Reports to: Executive Camp Director

Job Purpose: Allow God to lead spiritually, emotionally and physically as they maintain RNR property and buildings as well as coordinate and lead work teams and new construction projects. Will also be responsible for all Challenge course activities.

**Requirements:** 

- ✤ A personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Organizational skills and leadership skills, delegation abilities
- Must have a working knowledge of mechanics, construction and grounds maintenance
- Must be very safety conscience and follow B.C. construction and safety regulations.
- Must have High ropes training and be qualified to teach. Must be familiar with B.C. Challenge course Standards
- Must be UIM missionary, responsible for raising personal support.

Responsibilities: Overseeing all maintenance project, building projects, and grounds maintenance. As well as High ropes activities

- Oversees work teams and work staff year round
  - Ensure all things are being done for the glory of God
  - Ensure people are properly trained for their task
  - Ensure materials and tools are available prior to starting a task and in good and safe working order
  - $\circ~$  Ensure a high level of quality on all jobs

- Staff Issues
  - Be proactive in promoting good staff relations in an effort to ward off any issues. In case of staff issues arising, work through the issues with all parties. Any unresolved issues contact Camp Director
- Responsible for the structural integrity of all camp structures
- Responsible for ensuring a clean and safe property
- Assist the Director on all high elements staff training(Zip line, giant swing etc.) Oversee the training of staff for all high elements, insuring they up to date requirements for physical and emotional safety.
  - Maintain and review all high element courses and equipment
  - Responsible for staff training and certification on high elements
  - Ensure proper inspections off all high elements equipment and ensure proper records are kept
- Keep records of all equipment, service records, building plans, and all other documents related to maintenance
- Developing a camp maintenance budget

UIM Missionary Application Process: There are five stages to the process:

The Applicant (pre-acceptance, application)

The Candidate (pre-acceptance, interviews)

The Missionary Appointee (pre-field assignment, support raising)

The Field Missionary (two-year, first term)

The Senior Missionary (long-term)

Be sure that you are in agreement with the Statement of Faith and Position Statements.

The process of becoming a missionary with UIM International involves a substantial investment of resources like time and finances. The process is a lengthy one from the time of initial application to the time of actual long-
